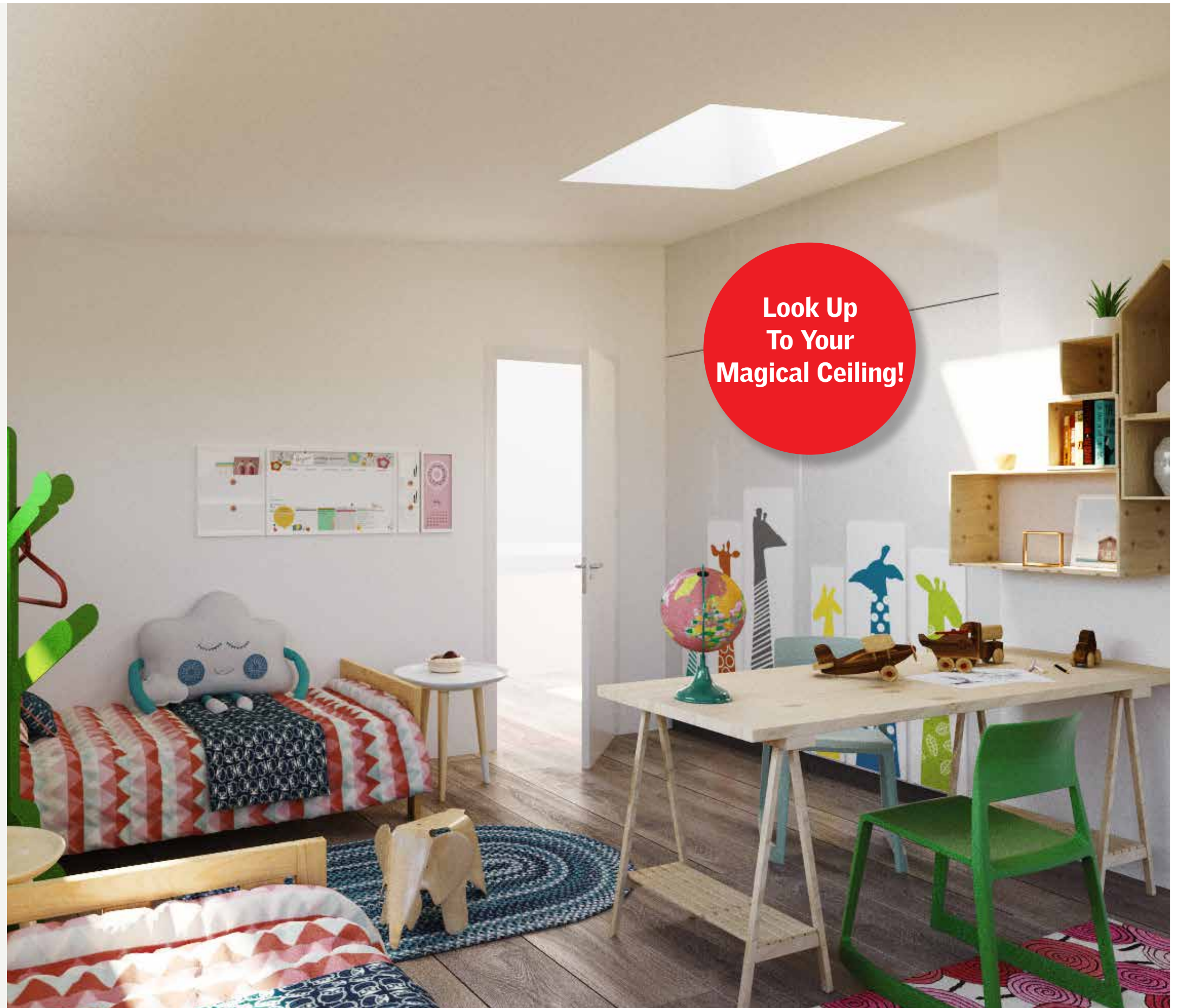

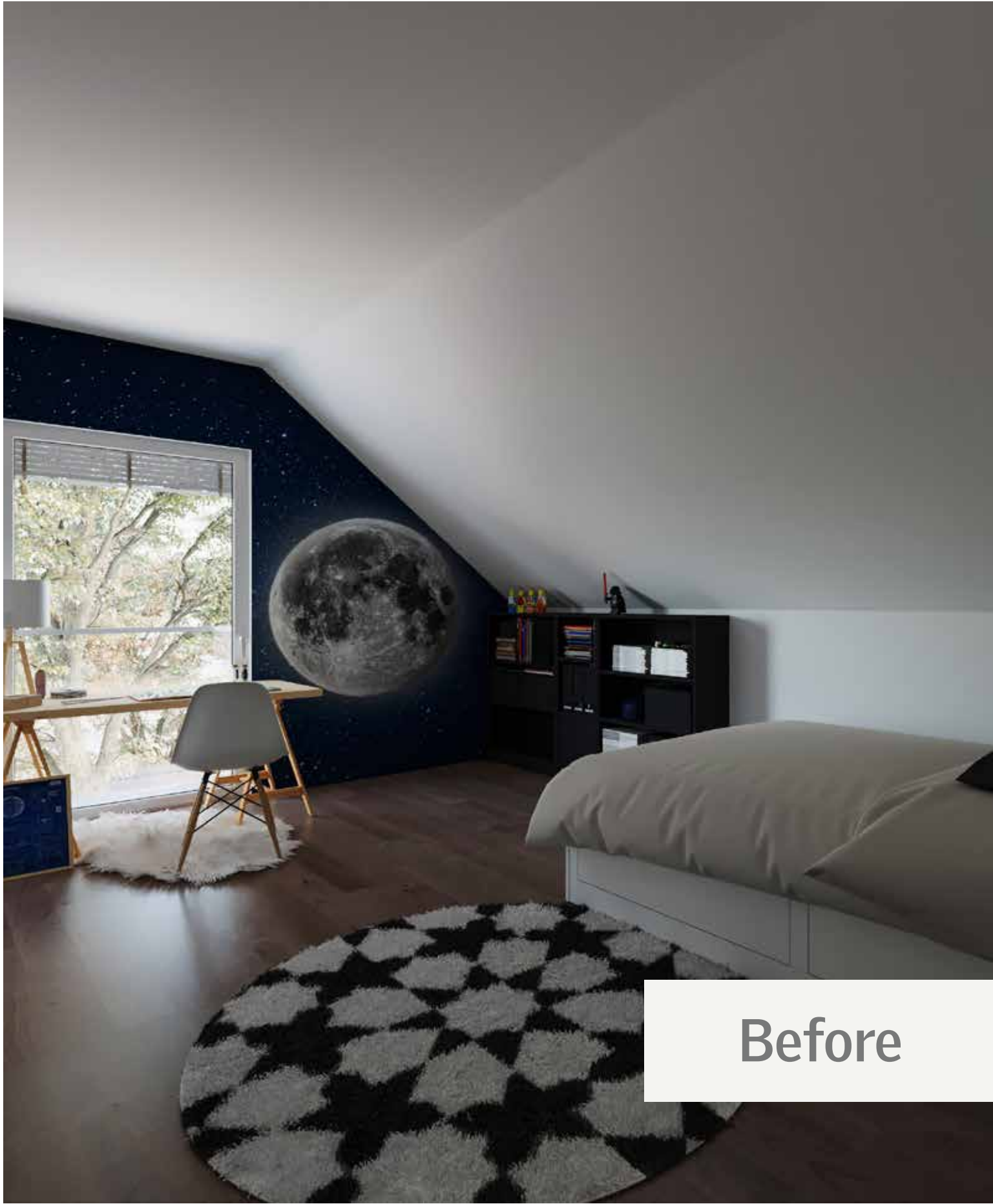

Daylight is an excellent source of Vitamin D, which promotes bone growth and cognitive functioning while helping prevent depression and weight gain. Exposure to daylight also influences serotonin production, which plays an important role in brain development. Increased levels of serotonin are also related to feelings of well-being and happiness in children, so when you can't go out, bring daylight in!

Sleep More Soundly

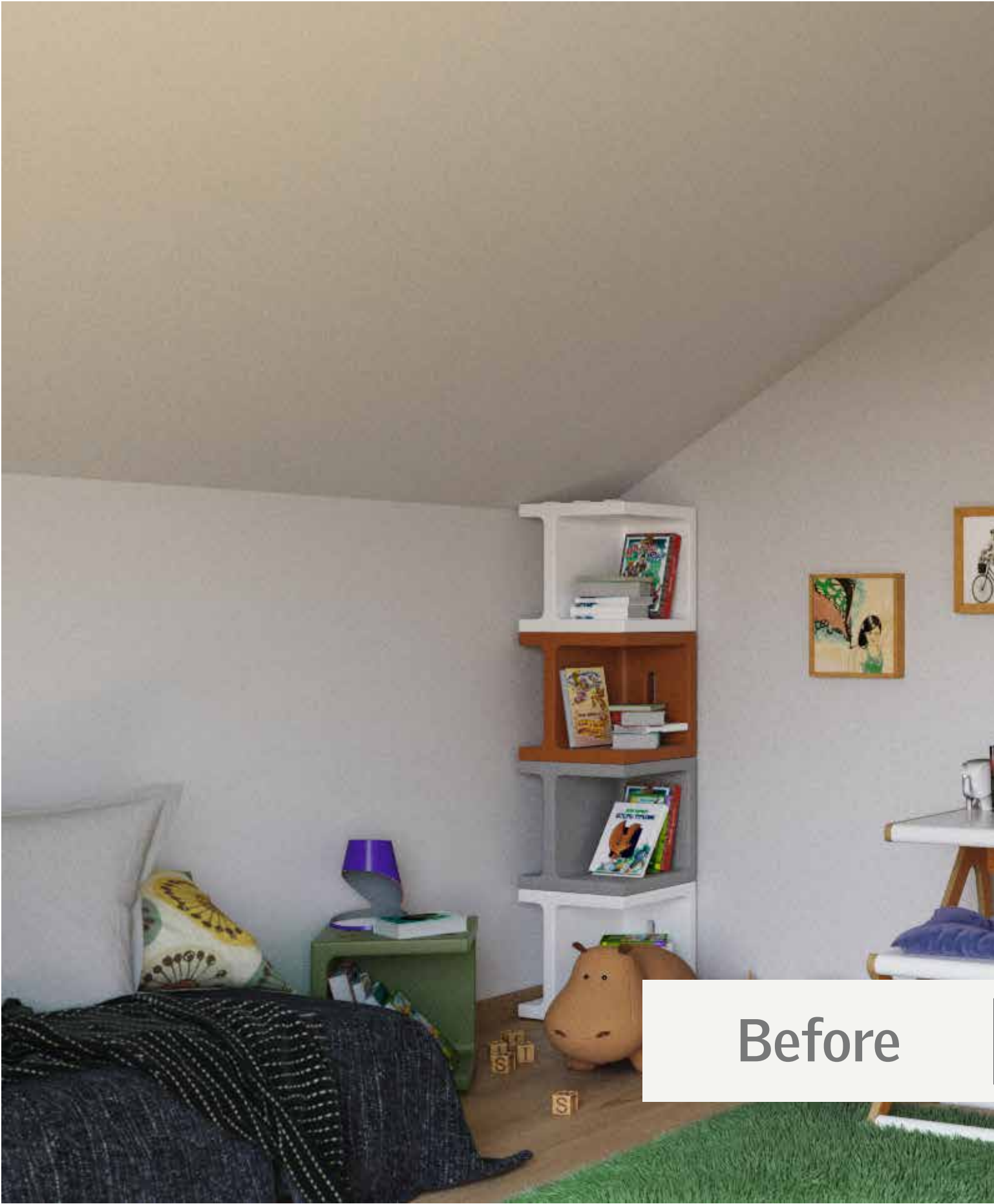
Depending on their age, kids need 9-13 hours of sleep per night, and daylight can help. Sunlight is an environmental indicator that helps set the body's circadian rhythm (sleep/wake cycle). In other words, it helps the brain learn when it's time to produce melatonin for us to fall asleep and acetylcholine for when it's time to wake up.

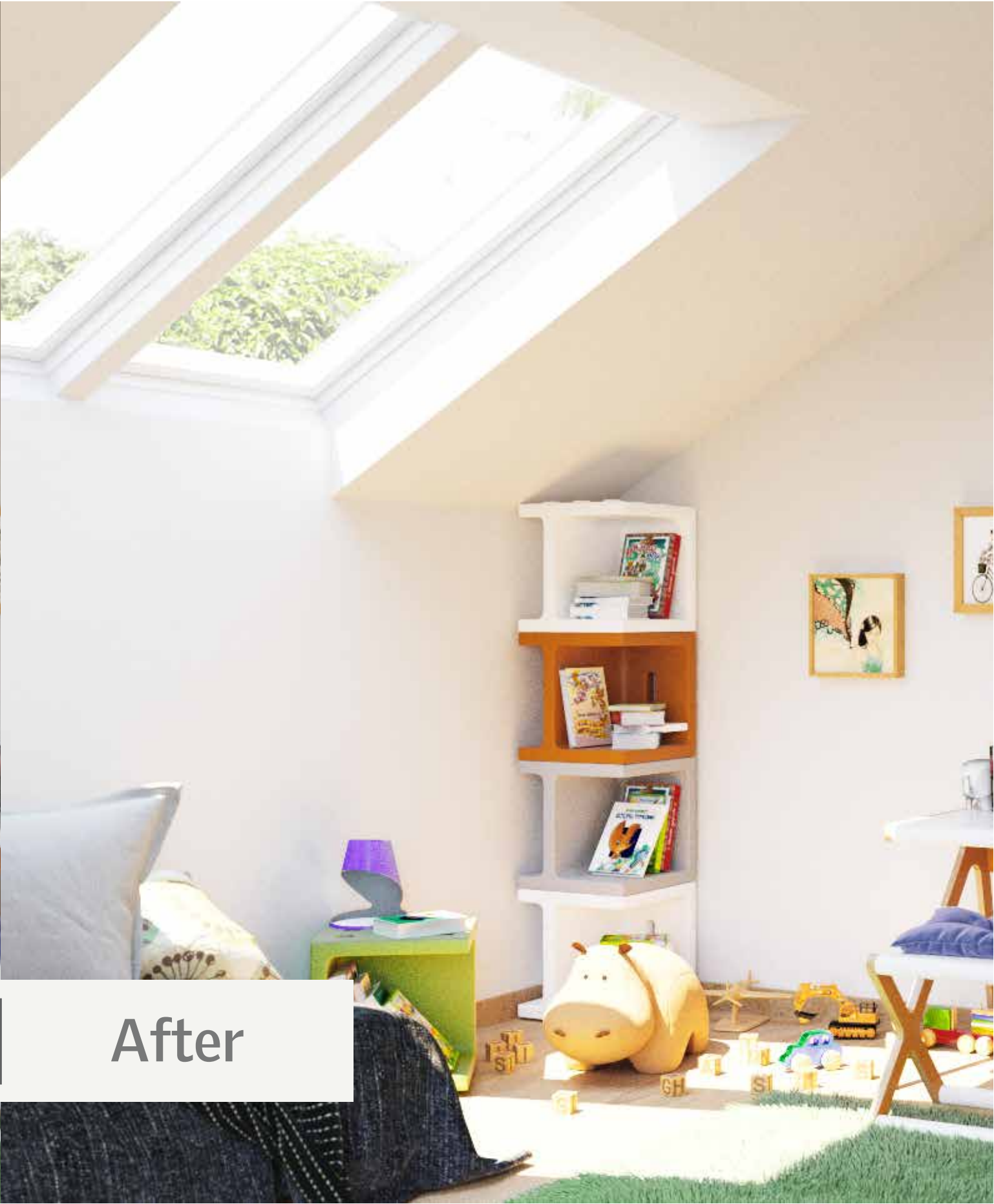
Promote Eye Health

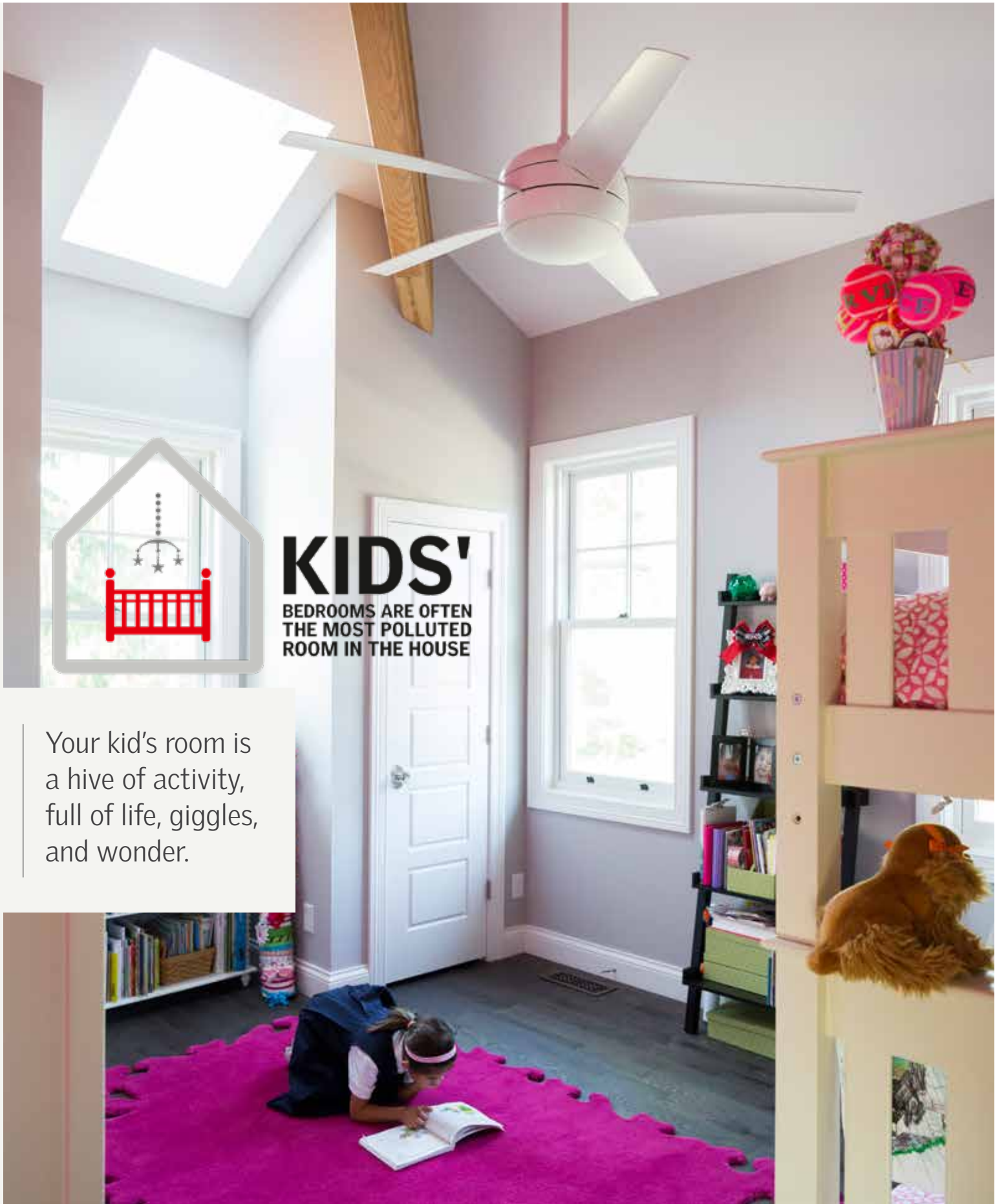
Making sure your kids get fresh air can also help inspire creativity and sharpen their minds. More

oxygen results in greater brain functioning, improving concentration skills and even moods. With all these benefits, it's pretty clear how important fresh air is to your kids' development!

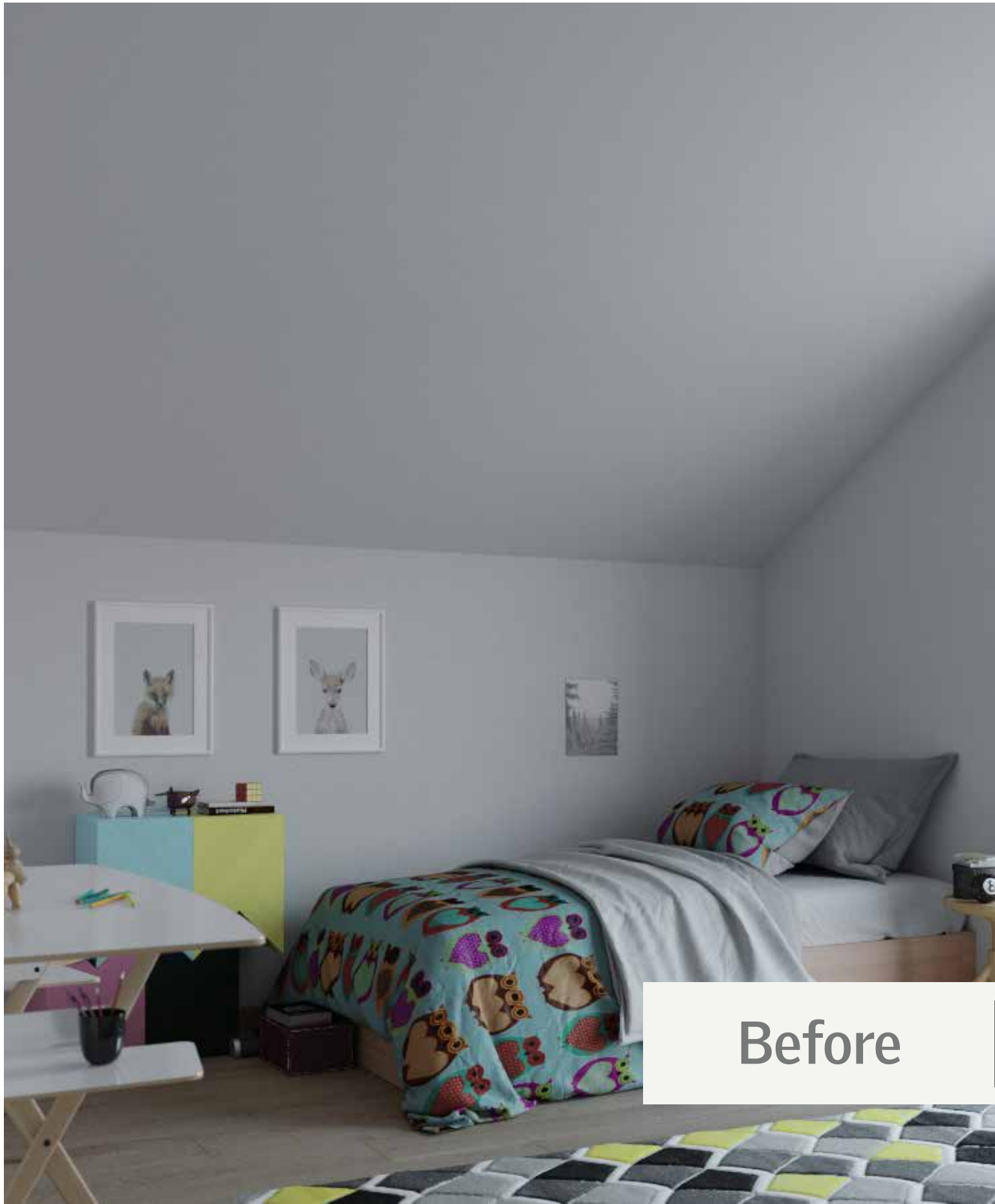
